Origin

Barrancas, Maipú, Mendeza. It is an area with soils of alluvial origin on the margin of the Mendoza River. It is a very benefited area because of its natural drainage. Its temperatures and micro-climate are very favorable for the excellent maturity of the grapes.

Notes

This wine is obtained from the co-fermentation between Malbec, Syrah, and Cabernet Franc. Harvested on the same day, thus enhancing the characteristics of each of these varietals that make up this great wine. It is designed from the vineyard to achieve an authentic, balanced rosé with wonderful natural Fruity expression and perfect varietal characteristics.
